Because of Ricky's lifelong love of sports and his compelling work with young people in the community, the Race was launched by his widow, Sherialyn Byrdsong, and family and friends in 2000 to honor his legacy and bring attention to the need to combat hatred in all its forms. The Race was entrusted to YWCA Evanston/North Shore in 2007.

YWCA Evanston/North Shore (E/NS) is dedicated to eliminating racism, empowering women, and promoting peace, justice, freedom, and dignity for all. Established in 1931, we are a nonprofit organization that works to stand up for social justice and strengthen local communities. We serve more than 8,000 people annually in northern Cook County through our Domestic Violence, Equity Institute, Economic Advancement, and Flying Fish Aquatics programs.

Proceeds from Race Against Hate are used to further the mission of YWCA Evanston/North Shore, in particular our efforts in the areas of racial justice and violence prevention. Your sponsorship of the Race helps support the following YWCA E/NS programs and initiatives:

- **Building Healthy Relationships** a relationship violence prevention curriculum designed to give young people the socialemotional skills they need to treat one another with respect, stop bullying, and prevent violence
- **Community Engagement and Events** Forums and events, including racial healing workshops and events, Race Against Hate, Unite Against Racism, and keynote expert discussions, which offer individuals the opportunity to come together around current issues of racial justice
- **Becoming Equitable Institutions (BEI)** Our Equity Institute delivers customized equity consultations for businesses and organizations to assess all aspects of the workplace—recruitment, hiring, employee engagement, client experience, HR policies, and more—through an equity lens, complete with action plans, custom training, and follow-up evaluation.
- Alternatives to Violence Our 26-week learning and education group for those who have caused harm provides the opportunity and skills to change the behavior, beliefs, and attitudes that support their use of violence against intimate partners.
- 40-Hour Domestic Violence Training YWCA E/NS is an approved ICDVP training site for 40-hour domestic violence training that provides a solid base of knowledge for anyone working with individuals affected by domestic violence using a trauma-informed lens.
- Equity Training and Workshops Racial equity trainings for groups and individuals who want to deepen their understanding of equity and learn actions they can take to level the playing field.
- **Comprehensive Sex Education** students learn about consent and determine their boundaries in a neutral environment, empowering them to gain the knowledge, confidence, and communication skills to make healthy relationship choices and seek support if a relationship is harmful.
